Cross Plains ISD denied the Chapter 313 application to ENEL Wind Energy on Oct. 21st 2020 This decision came after tabling the possible application at the Sept. 22nd Meeting where TXLC gave a presentation, multiple landowners expressed their concerns, and were supported by almost 100 landowners that were against the project.

ENEL Green Power North America will be presenting to the Cross Plain ISD to consider a Chapter 313 application for the Ranchland Project that is located Southwest of Cisco, North of Cross Plains and South of Putnam.

This project is part of a two part project. Ranchland Wind Project and Ranchland Wind Project II. Its important to note that Tradewind is an extension of ENEL Green Power.

Baird ISD was presented Ranchland II by Tradewind Energy and Cross Plains ISD Ranchland by ENEL. While Plans for ENEL's Ranchland has not been released, the plans for Ranchland II have. Those include 7, 2.4 MW Turbines and 19, 4.3 MW Turbines. The 4.3 MW turbines are in the FAA system at 660ft tall. 400ft Wind Turbines can be seen up to 22 miles away. The project area for Ranchland II falls 81% in Callahan County, 19% Eastland County, 74% Baird ISD, 19% Cross Plains ISD and 6% in Cisco ISD. This project shows turbines on the county line.

We believe the two projects if built will become one larger project together.

There is a unique opportunity here to stop the Ranchland project. Most schools have the meeting with the wind company before the public knows, but CPISD has invited the public to be involved before agreeing to an application.
